Application Information Instructions and Requirements

To apply for Leadership Beaver Dam:

Complete the following *Leadership Beaver Dam Application* and return it along with a \$50.00 commitment fee - 9% of the total cost - to:

To ensure the quality of this program, class size is limited, so the timely return of your application is encouraged.

Applicants will be notified as to whether or not they have been accepted in the program. Our goal is to accept all applications; however, if your application to this year's Leadership Beaver Dam program is denied due to class limitations or otherwise; your \$50.00 commitment fee will be refunded.

Upon acceptance, tuition is due and information will be forwarded regarding the specifics of the Leadership Beaver Dam Orientation and the schedule of classes for the 2010-11 program year.

Participation Information & Requirements

The investment fee to attend Leadership Beaver Dam is \$550.00, with a \$50.00, non-refundable, deposit up front and the remaining \$500.00 due upon acceptance to the program. The fee covers all instruction costs, class materials, morning refreshments, lunch meals, and the orientation dinner and graduation dinner costs. Potential participants are requested to pay the first \$50.00 with their application to confirm their commitment to the program. Beaver Dam area businesses and organizations are encouraged to underwrite the cost of tuition for individuals they send. Financial constraints will not automatically eliminate the possibility of being accepted as a participant in the program. If fees are an obstacle for your involvement, please indicate this in your application and the matter will be discussed with you confidentially.

Each participant is required to attend the following sessions:

- ◆ An introductory orientation, followed by an evening dinner in August. The 8:00 AM - 5:15 PM session will include only Leadership Beaver Dam participants, the program coordinator and support personnel. The 5:30 PM - 7:30 PM dinner will include Leadership Beaver Dam participants, the Leadership Beaver Dam Committee and program coordinator, participant sponsors, spouses and guest speakers.
- ◆ Monthly day-long sessions held at various locations throughout Beaver Dam. See class schedule dates for 2010/2011 that follow.
- ◆ The recognition and graduation banquet in June.



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Each participant is required to work collaboratively on a group project:

Each participant will select a project group early in the year. It is the intention that project goals and a project report will be completed by May, or rationale will have to be provided as to why components have not been completed prior to the beginning of summer. If, for instance, a fundraising event is planned to coincide with a summer time festival, all components of the planning, coordination, volunteer recruitment, etc. must be finished with a written report that is provided to the program coordinator by May, even if the event itself will not occur until later. Participants may need to commit to additional hours outside of class time with their group members to complete their group project. The personal and community rewards will be worth participants' efforts. Groups will be required to provide a report in May and make a presentation of their project at the graduation event in June.

Each participant will be assigned a mentor:

Each participant will be assigned a mentor for the year. The mentor will either be an individual from the Leadership Beaver Dam Committee or will be an alumnus of the program. Participants will be encouraged to maintain communication with their mentor throughout the class year.

Each participant can earn college credits:

Each participant can earn 3 college credits through Moraine Park Technical College upon successful completion of the Leadership Beaver Dam course. Should a LBD participant wish to take advantage of the college credits, an additional payment will have to be made to MPTC.
